The following items were addressed during workshop session:

Commissioner Hendrickson reported that the bollards, that were mandated by the insurance carrier, were installed near the diesel tank at the 18th avenue firehouse. There is still some signage that must be posted in the engine room.

Truck 1-88 is back from service. The bottle filling with the new system went well with only a few problems that were related to learning the new system.

The chief and deputy chief met with Director Newberry to discuss the issue of equipment that is needed or missing from truck 1-88. The chief will put together a list and report back to the Director.

Director Newberry reported that year to date truck 1-89 is just about \$13,000 into maintenance. It was explained to the engineers that if they think there is a problem with the truck, it will be looked at in house before a service company is contacted.

Fire Bureau no problems everything moving along ok.

Sale of surplus property - all the generators sold for \$3,705. A check for that amount will be given to the fire company at their June meeting.

All the paperwork for the change of the official depository is completed and the change will take place soon.

Fire Chief and Director vehicles, we have a Local Finance Board Application that Mr. Sendzik has submitted to the District. Director Newberry read a resolution prepared by Solicitor Sendzik for the Board to approve under regular session.

We have received multiple quotations on the new vehicles. Drawings have to be prepared before the Board can award any contracts.

We are still slated for June 12th for the Local Finance Board meeting.

PERS- no much to report right now, still having problems.

The chief and his officers have requested the purchase of 300' of 3" firehose color white to be put on truck 1-89 at a cost not exceed \$1900. The Board will act on this request during regular session.
