## BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS WALL FIRE DISTRICT NO.1

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The regular monthly workshop meeting of Wall Fire District No.1, Board of Fire Commissioners was called to order at 7:00 by Vice President Robert Hendrickson.

Administrator Newberry and Solicitor Sendzik also in attendance.

Administrator Newberry touched on the following items:

Equipment – There two apparatus related items that must be resolved. One is the outstanding issue with the ladder truck and the hydraulic pump. One quote we have now is \$5300. The other is the preventative maintenance schedule for 1-76 and 1-77. Seagrave has quoted \$2,982 for the service on 1-76 and 1-77. The quote for truck 1-88 is \$1,849 plus a PTO pm at \$299.00 and a light tower pm at \$299.00. In addition to that the Tahoe needs 4 new tires at a cost of \$833.00 on State Contract thru State Tire. The Board will move forward with the work on 1-76 and the new tires for the Tahoe.

Capital Improvements – Once the Budget goes through, the Board can start going out for quotations.

Policy Revisions – Solicitor Sendzik has them and will be presented during regular session.

Fire Bureau – Will be covered during Regular Session

Purchases – The first is a new copy machine. Administrator Newberry got a quote on leasing a Kyocera copier at a cost of \$117.92 for 60 months. This includes repairs, parts and toner. At the end on the 60 months the machine is returned and replaced with a new one. The next purchase is another mobile radio at a cost of \$8000.00. This radio will be installed in the present Chief's vehicle which will be come the Deputy Chief's car when the new Chief's vehicle is received. There purchases will be discussed again during regular session,
