Old Business

Air & Light Unit remount & refurbish:

SVI – for only the Spartan Cab & Chassis, and nothing else \$200,000.00.

Seagrave – No response back.

Campbell Supply – Spartan Cab including everything \$370,000.00.

They can also do a Freightliner at about \$115,000.00. and would give us a trade in on our Existing cab and chassis.

We will go out for public vote on the third Saturday in February from 2 to 9 pm, asking for an amount not to exceed \$395.000.00.

2022 Budget Capital Projects: We will have a meeting to adopt the annual budget January 20th at 3:30 p.m. at the Administrative Building.

Communications Upgrades: Progress

Fire Police Program: We are establishing the Fire Police Division of the Fire District. As of now this only pertains to fire company members. The Administrator is working with workers comp. on how to bring nonmembers into the program.

New Business

Chief / Officer Stipend:

Fire Chief will be compensated \$1,800.00 a year, \$450 quarterly. His duties are remaining the same.

Deputy Chief will receive \$1,000.00 a year, paid \$500 twice a year.

Captain & Lieutenants(s) the Board will provide a \$250 annual stipend, to be paid in addition to the clothing allowance in December of each year.

Training Reimbursement Policy: It's staying at \$80.00, we have added, each probationary fire fighter who is enrolled and attending fire fighter 1, shall be entitled to an allowance of up to \$40.00 to only be applied for his reimbursement of tuition enrollment fees for gym membership. Upon successfully completing fire fighter 1 program not before November calendar year requesting reimbursement shall be entitled to an additional \$40.00.

Resolutions: Resolution authorizing extension and modification of employment agreement. The personnel committee met with the Administrator and reviewed the revised contracts for Fire District Administrator, Deputy Fire Marshall, and Fire Investigator.

There being no further business to come before he Board at this time the meeting was adjourned at 7:27 p.m.
