APPROVAL OF MINUTES: A motion was made by Commissioner Curtis and second by Commissioner Davenport to accept the minutes of the previous meetings as submitted. The motion as moved and approved with all members present voting **YES.**

APPROVAL OF REQUISITIONS, VOUCHERS AND BILLS: A motion was made by Commissioner Curtis and second by Commissioner Miles to approve the bills and requisitions as submitted. The motion was moved and approved with all members present voting **YES.**

- C. A motion was made by Commissioner Miles and second by Commissioner Curtis authorizing he urgent repair of the HVAC equipment in the former Directors office, now the Chief's office at the 18th avenue fire house. The motion was moved and approve with all members present voting **YES**.
