WHEREAS, the budget as introduced is in compliance with the Property Tax Levy Cap Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.44 et seq.); and

WHEREAS, the Annual Budget as introduced reflects Total Revenues of \$1,535,426.00 which includes an amount to be raised by taxation of \$916,500.00 and Total Appropriations of \$1,535,426.00; and

WHEREAS, the amount to be raised by taxation to support the district budget shall be the amount to be certified to the assessor of the municipality to be assessed against the taxable property in the district, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:14-79. Such amount shall be equal to the amount of the total appropriations set forth in the budget minus the total amount surplus and miscellaneous revenues set forth in the budget; and

WHEREAS, in calculating the amount to be raised by taxation, the Fire District has taken into account the assessed valuation of taxable property in the Fire District;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the Fire District, at an open public meeting held on December 15, 2022 that the Annual Budget, including all related schedules, of the Fire District for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2023 and ending December 31, 2023 is hereby approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the anticipated revenues as reflected in the Annual Budget are of sufficient amount to meet all proposed expenditures/expenses and all covenants, terms and provisions as stipulated in the Fire District's outstanding debt obligations, capital lease arrangements, service contracts, and other pledged agreements; and

Total budgeted appropriations will increase \$273,031 or 21.6%. No unrestricted fund balance will be utilized in 2023, \$20,000 was utilized in 2022. \$11,587 of restricted fund balance will be utilized in 2023. No restricted fund balance was utilized in 2022. Capital appropriations will increase \$37,500 and debt service will increase \$86,465.

1. Misc anticipated revenues will increase \$11,115 or 19.5% due to a shared service agreeement with Wall District No. 2 for its business admin services. 2. Interest on inv and deposits will decrease \$329 or 21.4% to reflect anticipated earnings. 3. The District was awarded a \$34,000 CY2022(ARP-FFG)Grant which is also budgeted on Page (F-3 Detail) as (ARP-FFG)expenses. 4. Total revenue offset with approp \$65,000 or 16.6%. The Bureau is a shared service administered by Fire District No. 1 The Districts all agreed to increase their annual contributions for a fire prevention training and education iniative to be funded through the Bureau. 5. Other revenue-other reimb-Bureau has increased its insurance reimb to the District to keep up with the rate of premium increases. 6. Fringe benefits \$8,836 or 24.1% due to increased pension costs. 7. Training \$2,200 or 48.9%. There are new volunteers, resulting in an increase in training costs. Also, training facilities have increased enrollment fees. 8. Bureau of Fire Prevention-Please refer to 4. 9. Recruit/retention materials \$3,200 or 55.2%. The District works to recruit and retain its volunteer fire personnel resulting in new volunteers, and resinstatement of inactive volunteers. 10. Misc equipment \$2,000 or 100%. The fire police program was established in 2022 and requires tools & safety apparel necessary to perform their duties resulting in a 17.7% increase to misc equipment. 11. Equipment and repairs (\$1,000) or (35.7%). By sharing of resources, the Bureau has been able to reduce costs in the areas of equipment and office expenses resulting in a considerable cost savings. 12. Office expenses (\$945) or (12.7%). By sharing of resources, the Bureau has been able to reduce costs, especially in the areas of equipment and office expenses resulting in a considerable cost savings in these areas. 13. Postage \$200 or 10%. Postage fees continue to increase annually. The Bureau mails out all registration invoices. 14. Fuel \$4,000 or 100%. As fuel prices continue to increase, the Bureau now budgets this line separately to ensure there are adequate funds. 15. Training/education \$1,645 or 100%. To adhere to NFPA Standards the Bureau will be expanding its Fire Investigator training. The cost of classes have increased resulting in an increase in training costs. 16. Fire prevention training \$30,000 or 100%. Please refer to 4.

The amount to be raised by taxation will increase \$168,500. The proposed tax rate will increast \$.017 to \$.104 per \$100 of assessed valuation. No unrestricted fund balance will be utilized in 2023, \$20,000 was utilized in 2022. Restricted fund balance of \$11,587 will be utilized in 2023, none was utilized in 2022. The District is in compliance with the property tax levy cap.


