- B. Resolution Part time Administrative Assistant Fire Prevention: Fire Prevention is hiring a parttime Administrative Assistant, not to exceed 24 hours a week, at \$20.00 and hour. Her name is Callan Cotta, and she has her fire inspector's certification.
- C. APX Two Way Radios: We have found a vendor that has refurbished Motorola APX radios. Board has a quote for the Gallad Group Inc. for (2) radios at \$6300.00.
