### **Old Business**

#### A. Ladder 89 Repairs = Bid Specification

The Bid Specifications are complete. The specs are taking the deficient items in which it failed aerial test for, having those fixed in addition to replacing the reverse camera and monitor, replacing the flow meter gauge, plumbing the in-house air system. Also, in the bid specifications put on there for a bided labor rate valid for one year are the delivery of the truck for any other general repairs for that vehicle.

#### B. House Air Compressor = Installed. Plumbing. 1-89 hookup

The House Air Compressor has been installed. Plumbing to be completed.

#### C. Parking Lot paving = 18<sup>th</sup> Avenue Station.

The fire company has agreed to fund 50% of the Engineering work. We will move forward with the bid specs, and go out to bid something in March and a award date at April meeting.

### **New Business**

#### A. Budget 2026 = We received our approval today. We have the Resolution Adopting the District 2026 Budget pursuant to NJSA48-14-78.4 to be approved during regular session.

HVAC Upgrades = 18<sup>th</sup> Avenue Station = The present heating system in the engine room has caused damage to vehicle 1-89 and must be replaced. The Board agreed to have some heating vendors come in and submit ideas on how to efficiently heat the engine room.
