The regular monthly meeting of Wall Fire District No.1, Board of Fire Commissioner's was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by President Davenport

### **PUBLIC COMMENTS ON AGENDA ITEMS:** None

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES:** A motion was made by Commissioner Rogers and seconded by Commissioner Curtis to approve the minutes of the previous meeting as submitted. The motion was moved and approved with all members voting **YES**.

**APPROVAL OF REQUISITIONS, VOUCHERS AND BILLS:** There are two bills to be added to the bill list. They are in relation to the work performed on vehicles 1-88 and 1-85. PL Customs for \$351.04 and Ryan Scott for \$1,250.00. A motion was made by Commissioner Curtis and seconded by Commissioner Rogers to approve the bills and the requisition list as submitted. The motion was moved and approved with all members voting **YES**.

**TREASURERS REPORT:** Commissioner Rogers reported that the balance in the Citizens Payroll Account was \$18,107.17 and the balance in the Ocean First Operating Account was \$614,660.28. On a motion by Commissioner Curtis and seconded by Commissioner Contreras, all members voted to approve the Treasurers report as submitted.

## **OLD BUSINESS:**

- A. Ladder 89 Repairs = Bid Specification (posted Feb.2, due Feb. 26) = Ladder 1-89 went out for bids. The Board received no bids. The Chief has contacted Campbell Supply, and Bull Dog Fire Apparatus concerning the repairs. Hope to have more to report at the April meeting.
- B. House Air Compressor = Plumbing. 1-89 hookup = All the reels have been mounted, and most of the plumbing has been completed. A few additional parts need to be ordered.
- C. Parking Lot Paving – 18<sup>th</sup> Avenue Station = Work in progress.
- D. HVAC Upgrades = 18 Avenue Station = Met with 2 vendors. The Chief and Commissioner Curtis met with Polar Air, Commissioners Rogers and Stelling met with Environmental Air Systems. They are both working on their quotes.

## **NEW BUSINESS:**

- A. Service Agreement with Volunteer First Aid Squads = A motion was made by Commissioner Rogers and seconded by Commissioner Curtis to approve the Service Agreement with Volunteer First Aid Squad's that was presented to the Board by Chief Newberry during Workshop Session. The motion was moved and approved with all members voting **YES**.
- B. Length of Service Awards Program 2025 List = The current list of members who qualified will be posted for review for 30 days.
