Chief Bill Newberry, Deputy Chief Dave Hunt, and Captain Dan Campion were also in attendance.

Ladder 1-89 Repairs = Bid Specs. Were returned and discussed at last meeting. Dave Hunt worked with Mac Millan Machinc, a local vendor, he came up and did a float test on the truck. He gave us a quote to remove and reinstall the lift cylinders \$3,800. He is going to remove them, take them to Paterson. They will get repacked there and then reinstalled. As of meeting night we do not have a quote on the cost of the repacking itself. Once the cylinders are removed, we're told the truck will have to remain outside and cannot be moved. The Board will investigate a way the ladder came be secured and moved back into the building.

House Air Compressor = Compressor hooked up and running. Waiting for the fittings for the reels, which come with the auto ejects.

Parking Lot Pot Paving = Chief Newberry talked with French and Perilo concerning the Tech Specs. The Specs are complete. They must mated to the boiler plate specifications which the Board attorney will complete. We will probably being out to bid around April 20 with the return date in mid-May.

HVAC Upgrades = Commissioner Rogers is waiting for updates from the vendors he has been working with and will reach out to the vendor who is doing work at Dist. 2 firehouse.

LOSAP = The list has been posted, and the Board can approve that under Regular Session.

There being no further business to come before the Board at this time the meeting was adjourned at 7:15 p.m.
